It has been designed by W3C with the primary purpose of demonstrating new Web technologies in a What You See Is What You Get (WYSIWYG) environment. The current version implements the Hypertext Markup Language (HTML), Extensible Hypertext Markup Language (XHTML), Mathematical Markup Language (MathML), Scalable Vector Graphics (SVG), the animation module of Synchronized Multimedia (SMIL Animation), Cascading Style Sheets (CSS), and Hypertext Transfer Protocol (HTTP).
